

FILE PREPARATION: SCODIX

SUPPLYING ARTWORK WITH SCODIX ELEMENTS

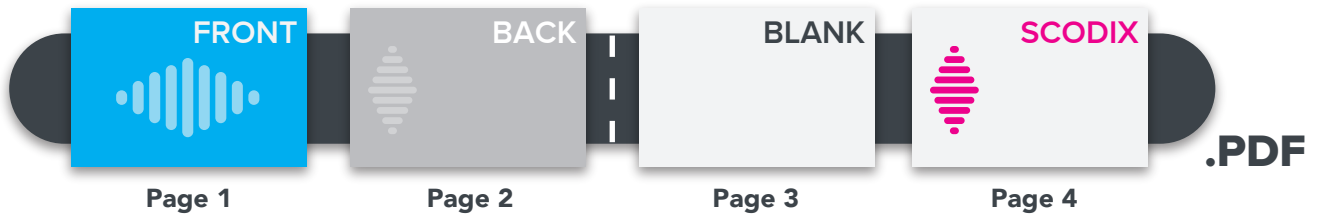
Supplying Scodix Artwork

When creating Scodix artwork, supply an extra page in your PDF with a duplicate of the elements you wish to enhance. This should be set as a **Spot Colour** named '**Scodix**'. For example, business cards would need to be supplied as 4 pages within one PDF:

1 For Scodix to be applied to the FRONT page:



2 For Scodix to be applied to the BACK page:



Please supply four pages within one PDF in the order shown above. This is to ensure pages are in the correct order when backing up your artwork. **1** 1st page including the front design of your business card. 2nd page including the back design. 3rd page with the Scodix element set in a spot colour. 4th page left blank. **2** 1st page including the front design of your business card. 2nd page including the back design. 3rd page left blank. 4th page with the Scodix element set in a spot colour.

Please do not supply the front and back pages of the business cards together with the scodix layer in a separate PDF. Ensure artwork is not supplied without a blank page as this will cause automatic rejection.



Double Check Trim/Fold Areas

Scodix cannot be applied over the score/fold areas of a folded product: e.g. Presentation Folders. Be sure to **leave 3mm from the edge of the trim area** as well as any score/fold area).
